


#### EMPOWERED CHANGEMAKERS


## TRANSFORMED CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

Connected communities are strong communities. CBNO is a bridge-builder and translator, convener and capacity builder. We're your ally for navigating and influencing what goes on at City Hall.




#### BUILT PARTNERSHIPS

# Healthy Soil for New Orleans' Grassroots


